As to the other moiety of the 80001., and as to the 50001., the power of appointment was limited to persons of her blood and kindred. The will of Catherine Goodrich Shedden contains no reference to any power of appointment. It contains no gift of her personal estate otherwise than by naming executors. It contains no gift of the residue of her personal estate.
