

The control of milk supplies was formerly confined to a chemical examination for adulteration, but since the beginning of the 20th century the bacteriological examination has been regarded as a sine qua non, and in America the present tendency is to have both examinations made under the supervision of the Public Health Authorities. For this reason no apology is necessary for the inclusion of chemical methods and the data which will enable the examiner to interpret the results obtained. In the bacteriological section an attempt has been made to include all methods that have been proved to be reliable and in some instances the details of the standard methods of the American Public Health Association have been given;...
