

Children at the age of four years are taught to knit, and the little weazened faces on the doorsteps that looked at us with eyes askance, the flaxen hair twisted in a little knot like their mothers, the bare feet and coarse though tidy gown, the poor little thin hands that so deftly plied the needles, all told of poverty, but honest poverty, the poverty that would toil on, suffer on,...
